



GOETHE INSTITUT EXAMINATIONS

(All classes)

Lycée Rodolphe Töpffer gives its students the opportunity of taking the Goethe Institut examinations, known throughout the world as an evaluation of the German language level of each candidate.

Preparing this examination of both written and oral comprehension and expression motivates the students in their use of the language of Goethe. The preparation is offered by the lycée and takes place during Friday afternoon refresher and advanced classes. The candidate settles the exam registration fees.

There are four possible levels, each candidate is evaluated on their own skills and knowledge and these levels are linked to the European framework of references for languages with level 1 corresponding to A1, level 2 to A2, level 3 to B1 and level 4 to B2.

We encourage our students, with the agreement of their parents, to register for this examination, the results of which are separate from school results. The German teachers will suggest which level to take in order to ensure the best possible chance of success.
